This will begin at an [Indigenous Research Collaboration Seminar](#) on Friday October 27, 1-4pm, in conjunction with the [19th annual Symposium on Indigenous Knowledge hosted by Four Directions ASC](#). The workshop includes a keynote by Alex McComber on community-university partnerships with the Kahnawake School Diabetes Prevention Project. A panel of community, student and faculty members will talk about their experiences in Indigenous research and the afternoon will conclude with a talking circle. Participation and feedback in the workshop will provide guidance to the planning committee for future initiatives.
