There are many examples of Fibonacci numbers that can be found all around us! From forests to gardens to supermarkets, Fibonacci numbers are a force of nature! Take for example...

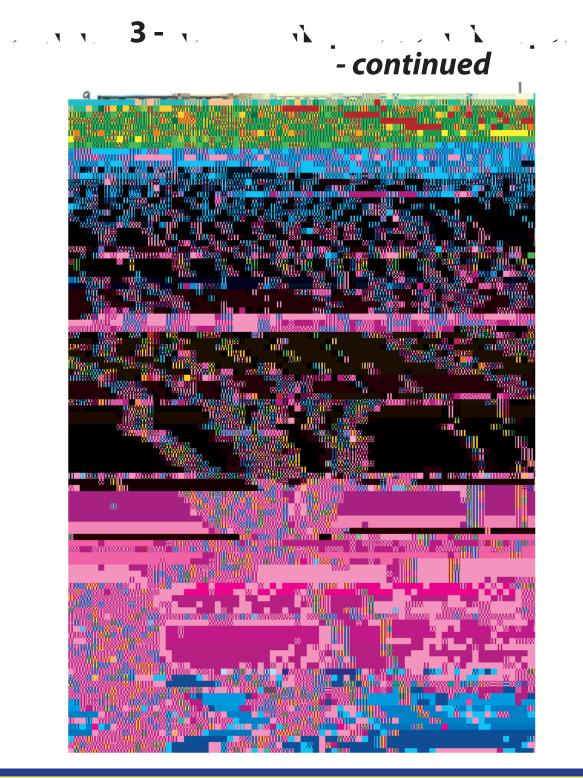
The total number of clockwise spirals on a sunfower head is 55. As well, the number of counter clockwise spirals on a sunfower head is 34. Pineapples also have eight seeds arranged in clockwise spiral order, and the number of seeds in a pineapple is 13 in a counter clockwise spiral.
