

The Canadian dollar is the type of currency used in Canada. The dollar sign (\$) is used to indicate its value. One Canadian dollar is divided into 100 cents. The symbol used to indicate a portion of one dollar is the cent symbol ( $\text{¢}$ ).

Currently there are 6 coins in circulation in Canada. They are the penny (worth  $1\text{¢}$ ), nickel (worth  $5\text{¢}$ ), dime (worth  $10\text{¢}$ ), quarter (worth  $25\text{¢}$ ), loonie (worth \$1) and toonie (worth \$2).

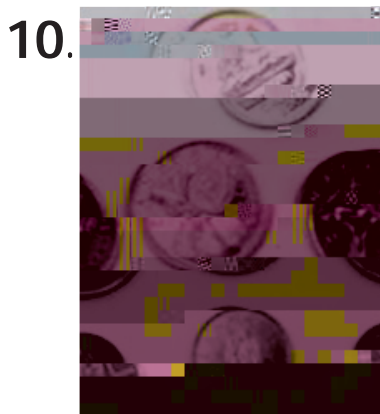
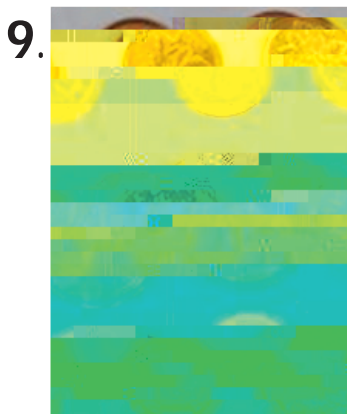
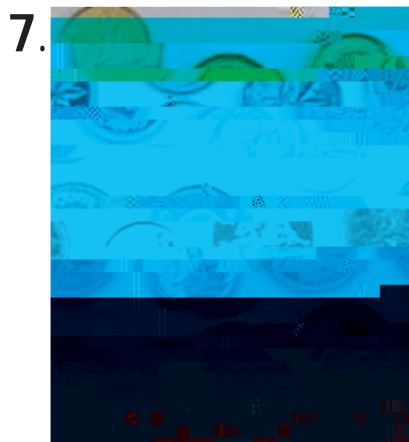
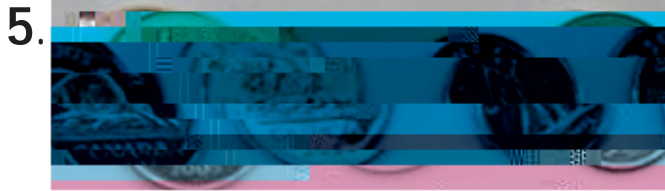
