
The Canadian dollar is the type of currency used in Canada. The dollar sign (\$) is used to indicate its value. One Canadian dollar is divided into 100 cents. The symbol used to indicate a portion of one dollar is the cent symbol (ϕ).

Currently there are 6 coins in circulation in Canada. They are the penny (worth 1ϕ), nickel (worth 5ϕ), dime (worth 10ϕ), quarter (worth 25ϕ), loonie (worth \$1) and toonie (worth \$2).






