2.4 Briefing Note to Propose a Response

A Briefing Note to prepare a response is designed to get everyone on the same page with respect to an event or statement that affects the user of the Note, but also the department or governments a whole. More than the question "What do we say about this?" in relevance here is the question "What do we all say about this?"

Response Briefing Notes are used to:

Develop an interpretation and response to events or changes in the environment

Assess the policy and program implications

Formulate a response in terms of both actions – "What are we doing?" and communications – "What are we saying about this?"

Assess the reactions to both the situation and the response.

Assess the risks.
